Notes on walk round 28th October 2018

Hazells Lane-

- Narrow lane only 7' wide at narrowest. Approach OCC for "narrow lane" sign at each end. Hedge to right of Hazells Lane to be cut back.

Goodenough Yard-

- Farm buildings look like they are no longer in use. Access to site could be over allotment site. No other information to date.

CWW-

- ECT to be contacted concerning replacement of the tree that fell down.

Bulls Close-

- Complaint about the crab apple tress dropping fruit. Little we can do about this it has been a bumper year for fruit. Groundsman will be approached to clear up the area under each tree.
- Contact highways concerning re-painting of white hatched area by entrance to Bulls Close.

Rouses Lane-

- Contact OCC for a sign at the bottom of Rouses Lane. Rouses Lane leading to Saxons Close and no through road symbol.
- Approach Gassons View re eucalyptus growing over the road. Needs to be cut back.

Bus Shelter-

- Project to install information boards around Filkins so visitors could have a trail they follow giving information on the history. ECT could be approached for educational grant.
- 20m stretch of road by St Peters House – Clerk to report.

Hardcastles Field-

- Willow trees need pollarding as they are touching the power lines. Arborforce and Fairford Tree Service to be asked to quote.
- Fence has been pushed over bordering Bridge Cottage. There are old fence panels and sand bags left to the side of the shed which have pushed the fence over. Craig Johnstone to be asked if he can remove these objects so the boundary fence can be re-established. Quote for replacing.

Street Lighting-

- All Councillors asked to look at street lighting and see where an extra one needs to be placed.
